**DIPLOMATIC NOTICE: GLOBAL TELECOMMUNICATION FRAUD, SEEKING
FOR REASONABLE PRICES AND COMPETITION MANDATE**

1. I, Mr. Kidima Mubarak Kim, Founder of the Independent Global Movement Voice, hereby issue this formal demand for an urgent and robust global investigation into the fraudulent practices of telecommunication giants.

1. **The "Data Rip-Off" Crisis:** In Australia, low-income citizens are being charged \$65 per month for internet services only to be blocked within 10-15 days, or \$39 for 28-day pre-paid Mobile Data only to be disconnected before expiry date. This is a direct theft of value from the most vulnerable members of the community.

2. **The African Continental Negligence:** The situation in African countries is even more severe, where costs remain a staggering barrier to the Right to Life and the Independent Voice. This is a violation of the UN's own sustainable development goals.

3. **The Demand for Independent Competition:** The Independent Global Movement Voice demands that all Governments:

Abolish Telco Monopolies: Immediately allow more Independent Telecommunications Competitors into the market to force a reduction in prices and better Services in the best interest of the Community.

Mandate Value-for-Dollar: Legislate that if a person pays for a month, they must receive unblocked access for the full 30 days. There must be reasonable Prices and it's about empowering the Individual against the "Systematic Oppression" of big Corporations.
