Also I had a plan of opening up a Factory of Gonja in Kasese-Uganda so that can be imported into Australia. Furthermore, a plan of opening up more than Twenty Restaurants for Alkebulanian food in the best interest of the Australian Community.

To provide a good and much longed Services to the Alkebulanians, Asian and Australian Community in general. To promote Social Economic Transformation for both Uganda and Australia.

To improve Standards of Farmers involved in Matooke, maintaining Quality Supply of Matooke, Job Creation and maintaining Diplomatic relationship with our Counter Parts.

I STRESSED THAT, THIS COMMUNICATION IS IN DIRECT SERIOUS URGENT COMPENSATION CLAIM OF \$792,500 UNDER SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES AS LISTED ABOVE, WITHOUT FURTHER DELAY IN THE BEST INTEREST OF HUMAN RIGHTS VALUES AND TO PROTECT THE INTEGRITY OF THE COMMONWEALTH, GENERAL GOVERNMENT SECTORS UNDER FINANCE MATERIAL, NATIONAL AND INTERNATIONAL LAW AND FOR THE JUSTICE OF MY CAUSE.

These petitions have been ignored, dismissed due to a bad Culture of Negligence, Clever racism with a "fake Smiles," or buried under bureaucratic bias. This narrative of neglect is the exhibit of the Systemic injustice I seek to correct.

Australia's Economy is Struggling because of having Such leaders who are not interested in Supporting our Local Community to prosper in the best interest of promoting our nation's economy. Had the Government Supported my ideas, I couldn't have been in this bad environment. I was almost been killed by Georgia Rose Kelly's negligence on the road due to lack of Government Support for a better future.

## II. THE MACRO VISION: ALKEBULAN AND THE IGMV MANDATE:

### 1. Restoration of Identity:

We formally reject the Colonial designation "Africa." Henceforth, the Continent is redesignated as Alkebulan (the "Mother of Mankind"). This is a reclamation of ancestral dignity and a foundational Step in our global reform.

Calculate and grant me a Shareholder percentage of the proceeds from every kilogram of Matooke imported into Australia Since 2015 to the present day, and continuing into the future.

This compensation is a debt owed for the vision I pioneered.

**Accountability:** The exploitation of my work must end. I demand that the Current "Cover-up" operations cease. I am a humble Servant to the Global Community, and I insist on the right to enjoy the fruits of my God-given Common sense and vision.

#### IV. FINAL RESOLVE:

Let it be known that my resolve is absolute. I do not Stand alone; I stand with the truth of our ancestors and the aspirations of the (IGMV). If these demands for recognition and restitution are not met with positive action, the Global Community Stands ready to Claim what is rightfully ours in the name of Justice, Unity, and Happiness.

Thank you for your letter dated 16 October 2011 regarding your proposal to import Matooke fresh green bananas to Australia from Uganda.

I commend you on both your initiative and your sense of community regarding this proposal.

As advised in November 2008 by the Western Australian Government Minister for Agriculture and Food, the initial consideration and risk assessment of fresh fruit entering Australia is under the jurisdiction of the Commonwealth Government.

Imports into Australia are governed by the Australian Quarantine and Inspection Service (AQIS) and the Department of Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry.

Currently the Australian Government does not allow the importation of fresh bananas into Australia. However, I am aware of an application by the Government of the Philippines to export bananas to Australia which is currently going through an assessment process with the Commonwealth Government.

If you plan to proceed with your project, in the first instance you will need to contact the Plants, Grains and Horticulture division of AQIS for information and assistance regarding the necessary process you will have to undertake to seek approval to import the bananas from Uganda.

Thank you for your correspondence of 4 September 2008 to the Prime Minister, the Hon. Kevin Rudd MP, about the potential importation of green raw bananas from Uganda. Your letter has been forwarded to the Hon. Tony Burke MP, Minister for Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry, as the matters you raise fall within his portfolio responsibilities. Minister Burke has asked me to reply on his behalf.

Australia does not currently allow the importation of fresh bananas from any source. However, since 2000 Biosecurity Australia has been preparing a risk analysis report examining the request by the Philippines Government to export bananas to Australia. I expect that a final report will be released shortly and be open to an appeal period.

Any application to import fresh bananas into Australia will need to conform to, and be assessed through, Australia's import risk analysis (IRA) process. The IRA process is outlined in the IRA handbook that is available on Biosecurity Australia's internet webpage ([www.daff.gov.au/data/assets/pdf\\_file/0011/399341/IRA\\_handbook\\_2007\\_WEB.pdf](http://www.daff.gov.au/data/assets/pdf_file/0011/399341/IRA_handbook_2007_WEB.pdf)).
