SECTION I: PETITION TO THE UNITED NATIONS:

- 1. Allegation of Administrative Omission and Bias:** This petition formally requests an immediate “Independent administrative review” into the handling of previous complaints submitted to “United Nations oversight bodies”. It is argued that the response, or lack thereof, constitutes a departure from the mandated principles of impartiality and diligence required under the “Universal Declaration of Human Rights and the United Nations Charter”.
- 2. Framework for Review:** The petitioner calls upon the relevant Special Rapporteurs and Working Groups to examine whether standard operating procedures were overlooked, and to ensure that the right to a fair, unbiased review of grievances is upheld in accordance with international administrative standards.

SECTION II: SUBMISSION TO THE INTERNATIONAL CRIMINAL COURT.

- 3. Request for Jurisdictional Assessment:** This communication is submitted to the Office of the Prosecutor to formally request an evaluation of previous filings. The International Criminal Court (ICC) is requested to determine if the documented circumstances fall within the strict legal definitions of the Rome Statute, specifically regarding systemic violations that may meet the threshold for international judicial intervention.
- 4. Exhaustion of Remedies and Accountability:** The petitioner notes that regular channels have been engaged without resolution, creating a necessity for an “independent international body” to assess the material facts and determine appropriate legal accountability.

SECTION III: CASE FOR SYSTEMIC INQUIRY REGARDING PROTECTION FAILURES.

- 5. Failure to Uphold the Duty of Care:** The petitioner requests an independent inquiry into the failure of relevant authorities to exercise their mandated duty of care. Under international human rights frameworks, international bodies and state actors possess an affirmative obligation to take proactive measures to protect individuals when credible threats to their life, liberty, and personal security are brought to their attention.
- 6. Accountability for Omission and Negligence:** This inquiry must examine whether the prolonged inaction by oversight bodies, despite numerous prior formal complaints, constitutes a systemic failure or procedural bias. When international institutions allow documented rights violations to continue without intervention, it undermines the core protections guaranteed under the “Universal Declaration of Human Rights and the UN Charter”. The petitioner demands a formal review to determine why protective protocols were not activated.

Bear in mind that, illegality cannot be considered legal. “Immediate action must be taken against all Criminal Suspects”.
