Distinguished Excellencies, VIP Colleagues, and Global Community,

SUPREME DECREE AND DEMAND FOR IMMEDIATE UNITY, PEACE, AND PROSPERITY ACROSS THE MIDDLE EAST AND THE GULF REGION.

Reference is made to my previous Decrees establishing that there can never be any war without the permission of His Excellency Mr. Kidima Mubarak, Leader and Founder of the Independent Global Movement Voice (IGMV).

By virtue of the powers entrusted to me by Almighty God "Allah" and in strict accordance with the Sovereign mandate set forth in the Independent Voice Book (the Global Constitution),

I, His Excellency Mr. Kidima Mubarak, hereby formally reaffirm my previous Decrees regarding the matters mentioned above. I declare that all wars and disunity among state leaders "must" cease immediately.

CALL FOR REGIONAL DECREE AND DIPLOMACY:

I demand that:

His Excellency, Supreme Leader Mojtaba Khamenei of the Islamic Republic of Iran,

His Excellency Recep Tayyip Erdoğan of the Republic of Turkey,

His Excellency Mr. Asif Ali Zardari of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan,

His Royal Highness Crown Prince Mohammed bin Salman of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, and others

"must" issue a unified Decree, endorsed by all parties, ending their grievances in the spirit of brotherhood for Unity, Peace, and Prosperity. This action is demanded pursuant to the Quran Al-Kareem (the Muslim



Constitution) and **Articles 1, 2, 3, 6, and 29** of the **Universal Declaration of Human Rights**.

MANDATES CONCERNING YEMEN AND THE GULF:

Disbanding Factions and Establishing Governance: I demand that all fighting groups in Yemen **"must"** be disbanded, granted a blanket of amnesty, and be compelled to form a unified government. Unity **"must"** be restored in the Arab Gulf Region, and all actions causing instability **"must"** cease immediately.

UN Security Guarantees: I demand that The United Nations **"must"** provide security guarantees until these groups are fully united, pursuant to **Article 21** of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights.

Integration of Forces: I demand that all forces **"must"** be integrated into a unified Yemeni national force dedicated to peace, unity, stability, and prosperity.

Humanitarian Infrastructure and Housing: I demand that The United Nations **"must"** enforce immediate humanitarian support, including the provision of infrastructure, Executive free housing, and free Commercial Vehicles to support the Yemeni government and its people, pursuant to **Articles 17, 20, and 22** of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights.

Enforcement Bodies: I demand that The United Nations Millennium Development Goals Fund (**MDGF**) and Sustainable Development Goals Fund (**SDGF**) **"must"** enforce this Decree immediately and report back to me with updates **within (7) days**.

CONFLICT RESOLUTION AND INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS:

End to Hostilities and Blockades: I demand that Israel **"must"** permanently end the war with Iran and its regional allies. The United States of America **"must"** lift the Naval blockade of Iranian ports and withdraw its military presence in the area.

Reparations and Sanctions Relief: I demand that all parties **"must"** work toward financial compensation for war damages, lift all international



sanctions, and unconditionally release frozen assets as a gesture of long-lasting peace, unity, and prosperity in the best interest of the global community.

Gaza and Hostage Release: I demand that all Israeli forces **"must"** withdraw from Gaza for the sake of peace, unity, prosperity, and sovereignty. All hostages and prisoners across the region **"must"** be released immediately.

De-escalation and Maritime Transit: I demand that The United States of America **"must"** cease threatening the Islamic Republic of Iran. Furthermore, the Strait of Hormuz **"must"** be reopened under the protection of the Islamic Republic of Iran in the best interest of the global Community—particularly for our brothers and sisters in **East Alkebulan** and **"Alkebulan"**, who are severely impacted by these Conflicts of interest—pursuant to **Article 13** of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights.

WARNING: Be reminded that disobeying my Decrees by continuing illegal warfare without my permission contravenes **Articles 4 and 5** of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, as well as **Articles 5, 6, and 7** of the Rome Statute of the International Criminal Court (ICC).

HUMANITARIAN CONTEXT AND SYSTEMIC ANALYSIS:

You all know that, Special Rapporteur reports, UN Human Rights experts, and independent bodies have repeatedly released comprehensive findings detailing mass casualties, the weaponization of starvation, and the systematic dismantling of housing, healthcare, and educational infrastructure across the Middle East and Gulf region.

FINDINGS ON INTERNATIONAL LAW AND INSTITUTIONAL DEADLOCK:

The United Nations Independent International Commission of Inquiry concluded that Israel bears responsibility for committing acts of genocide, targeted killings of civilians (**including men, women, and children**), and imposing conditions of life calculated to bring about the physical destruction of Palestinians in Gaza, Iran, and other locations across the region.



Although the United Nations General Assembly has passed resolutions demanding immediate ceasefires, unhindered humanitarian aid, and compliance with international law, enforcement mechanisms remain severely constrained. While investigations and legal cases proceed, the perception of institutional neglect often stems from structural limitations within the United Nations Security Council. Permanent Members possessing veto power (such as the United States, Russia, Britain, and others) have frequently blocked or diluted enforcement resolutions. This dynamic leaves innocent people dying while protecting strategic interests, rendering the UN politically deadlocked regarding coercive military or economic interventions.

THE YEMENI CRISIS AND HUMANITARIAN IMPACT:

Key actors operating in Yemen include the Saudi-backed Presidential Leadership Council (PLC), the Emirati-backed Southern Transitional Council (STC), and the Iranian-backed Houthis. The ongoing battle for control over Yemen's 42 million people has resulted in devastating humanitarian consequences:

Civilian Toll: Innumerable innocent men, women, and children have perished as a result of internal conflict. This destruction “must” cease immediately; instability and oppressive governance “must” end in the public interest. No faction can legitimately claim to act in the public interest while causing harm to innocent civilians, particularly children, the elderly, and persons with disabilities.

Political Stalemate: Neither side has succeeded in unifying the country, leading to a prolonged territorial and political stalemate. Tensions and localized clashes persist alongside diplomatic maneuvering. The rhetoric of expanded arms production “must” immediately give way to peace, unity, and security.

Humanitarian Statistics: According to United Nations data, at least 17 million people—roughly half of Yemen's population—face acute food shortages. UN reporting indicates that millions face Phase 3 (Crisis) and Phase 4 (Emergency) level food insecurity. Furthermore, approximately 11



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million children urgently require humanitarian assistance, nearly 20 million people overall require dire aid, and roughly **4.8 million** people remain internally displaced from their homes.

BINDING DECLARATION AND EXECUTION:

Please note that this Decree serves as a legally binding declaration. Let all authorities, governments, and international bodies take formal notice of this final Decree.
