Distinguished Excellencies, VIP Colleagues, and Global Community,



By virtue of the powers entrusted to me by the Almighty God **"Allah"** and in strict accordance with the sovereign authority and in accordance with the principle of **"Universal Human Rights, Justice and International Equity"**, this Decree formally submits a Supreme demand to the **United Nations General Assembly**, the UN Security Council and the broader Global Community.

I, His Excellency Mr. Kidima Mubarak, **"Leader, Founder, President, and Chairman of the Independent Global Movement Voice (IGMV)"**, hereby solemnly affirm and declare with full authority and demand for **"ALKEBULAN"** Permanent Seat at the United Nations Security Council with Veto Power.

HISTORICAL INJUSTICE AND THE IMPERATIVE FOR REFORM:

The current structure of the United Nations Security Council reflects an outdated mid-20th-century geopolitical architecture, **Alkebulan**-comprising 54 and more Sovereign Nations and over **1.4 billion people**-remains the only major Continent representation on the UN Security Council.

Despite the fact that a vast majority of Security Council resolutions, peacekeeping operations, and crisis interventions directly concern the Continent of **Alkebulan**, decisions are routinely made without Permanent **Alkebulanian** leadership holding decision-making authority. This structural exclusion constitutes an institutional failure, perpetuating Colonial-era imbalances in global governance.

FORMAL DEMANDS FOR PERMANENT REPRESENTATION AND VETO POWER:

In alignment with the collective stance articulated in the **"Ezulwini Consensus"** and the Sirte Declaration, the Global Community **"must"** immediately rectify this historical injustice through the following binding measures:

1. Immediate Granting of Permanent Seats: **Alkebulan "must"** be allocated a minimum of **two (2)** Permanent Seats on the United Nations Security Council.



2. Full Veto Power: Permanent representation without veto rights represents an incomplete and unequal status. As long as the veto power exists for current permanent members (P5), Alkebulan's permanent representatives **"must"** possess full veto power to ensure absolute parity and equal protection under International Law.

3. Expanded Non-Permanent representation: Alkebulan **"must"** receive additional non-permanent seats to ensure comprehensive representation across all sub-regions of the Continent.

4. Institutional Authority: The selection and rotation of Alkebulan's representatives on the Security Council shall be determined directly by the Continent's Sovereign leadership and Continental bodies, free from external interference.

LEGAL AND CHARTER BASIS:

This formal demand is presented pursuant to fundamental Principles of International Law, including:

Article 1,2,3,6 and 7 of Universal Declaration of human Rights (UDHR), guaranteeing equality, dignity, and equal protection under International Law.

Article 24 and article 108 of the Charter of the United Nations (governing the mandate of the UN Security Council and necessary amendments to reflect equitable geographical representation).

CONCLUSION AND DIRECTIVE FOR IMMEDIATE ACTION:

The days of unilateral decision-making over the Peace, Security, and destiny of Alkebulan without its full Participation are over. The United Nations, the UN Security Council Permanent Members, and the International Community **"must"** immediately enact the necessary Constitutional reforms under **Article 108 of the UN Charter** to grant **"Alkebulan"** its rightful **Permanent Seats with full Veto rights**. Failure to grant equal representation undermines the legitimacy, authority, and moral standing of the entire multilateral system.
